Approval of the minutes of the meeting of June 21, 2011

Dr. Roden moved approval and Dr. Williams seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Appointment of Vice Chair

Dr. Tom Coates nominated Dr. Sharon Campbell, who respectfully declined. Dr. Paulette Alexander nominated Dr. Patricia Roden. There being no further nominations, Dr. Roden was elected by acclamation.

Addition of Director of Interdisciplinary Studies as a non-voting member

By consensus, the Director of Interdisciplinary Studies was added as a non-voting member of the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.

Consideration of the request from the Department of Sociology for revisions to the Certificate in Gerontology program – revisit from the 6-21-11 meeting

Dr. Williams moved approval and Dr. Coates seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Transfer Computer Science program from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science in the College of Arts and Sciences to the Department of Computer Information Systems in the College of Business

Dr. Coates moved approval and Dr. Campbell seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Consideration of the request from the Department of Physics and Earth Science for a change in course number and description, ES 380

Dr. Campbell made a motion and Dr. Jones seconded the motion to approve the requested revisions, to include the elimination of BI, CH, ES, and PH 380 and notification to the

Curriculum Committee upon State Department of Education approval. The motion was approved unanimously. Because the course must be tied to one department for Banner purposes,
